

# Stoke Climsland Annual Parish Meeting

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 6<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2008 IN THE PARISH HALL, STOKE CLIMSLAND,

M Cox welcomed those present and opened the meeting with a brief explanation of the reasons behind holding another public meeting to discuss the proposed affordable housing project.

Steve Parsons gave an overview of how the SCCLT was formed and the current membership makeup of the group.

Peter Moore - gave an overview of how CRHA may be involved in the project

The meeting was opened up to the public for a question and answer session.

The main concerns expressed by members of the public present were:

- the make up and committee of the SCCLT not providing a balance of members from the immediate village of Stoke Climsland
- the lack of consultation between the parish council, SCCLT and the community
- the lack of an appropriate survey to determine "actual need"
- that the village may end up with a housing development that is inappropriate for the needs of the village
- the rumour mongering surrounding the proposed project which is causing a certain amount of sensationalism within the parish
- the identification and suitability of sites within the parish
- the suitability of the existing infrastructure and its ability to support additional housing within the village.

Following a lengthy discussion the meeting closed the question and answer session and thanked all those present for attending.

The meeting closed at 9.30pm.
