MINUTES OF AN EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF STOKE CLIMSLAND PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 24TH NOVEMBER 2008
COMMENCING AT 7.30PM IN THE PARISH HALL, STOKE CLIMSLAND

1. HOUSING NEEDS SURVEY.
