2008/02138 Land Adjacent to Burnbrae, Higher Downgate - demolition of existing building and erection of dwelling with septic tank and formation of access to Burnbrae. It was proposed by C Vulliamy, seconded by S Howard with all councillors voting not in favour of supporting the application for approval. The following observations were noted:-

- the proposed development is out of keeping with the existing dwelling
- the proposed development will be too close to the existing dwelling
- environmental impact
- removal of the large mature broad leaf tree
- the removal of the existing off road parking - parking on an already dangerous junction
- this property is key to the character of the settlement
- the design of the proposed development is out of keeping with the area.
