MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF STOKE CLIMSLAND PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 17<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2009 COMMENCING AT 7.30PM IN THE PARISH HALL, STOKE CLIMSLAND

P Barriball welcomed the two new councillors to the meeting.

## SC 09/8/1 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from M Cox.

## SC 09/8/2 Public Session

The complaint from one household on the village green regarding the installation of the new play equipment was discussed at length and noted. A history of the project was provided. It was also noted that there has been a lengthy consultation period lasting approximately 21/2 years where members of the public have had an opportunity to put their comments to the parish council. It was further noted that a post installation ROSPA inspection will be carried out on the equipment before it is officially open to members of the public to use.

## SC 09/8/3 Declarations of Interest

P Barriball declared an interest in planning application 2009/01033 Sunnyside

## SC 09/8/4 Minutes of Previous Meeting held on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2009

Subject to the minor amendments, the minutes of the meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2009 were signed by the Chairman as a true record of the meeting.

## SC 09/8/5 Matters Arising

a) Applications for post of parish councillor - update - the newly elected parish councillors are now in post. The process of the election and the potential financial implications that it will have on the parish council were discussed and noted. Although it is recognised that the democratic process should not be lost there clearly needs to be a review of the costs associated with any election. It was agreed the clerk would write to CALC and Cornwall Council regarding this matter.

b) Allotments Rubbish at Venterdon - letter from tenant - the letter from the tenant at Venterdon was noted. It was agreed C Davey would discuss this matter with the tenant.

c) Kyl Cober adoption of Highway - S Tudor and the Clerk gave an update on the situation. It was agreed the clerk would ask for a regular update from Cornwall Council regarding this matter.

## SC 09/8/6 Planning

2009/01033 Sunnyside, Lockett - Extension to dwelling two storey to side with single storey link to existing building D Parsons chaired the meeting for this item, C Vulliamy declared an interest in this item, it was proposed by S Howard seconded by S Cazaly with 4 councillors in favour of supporting this application for approval, 2 councillors abstained from voting. A lengthy discussion surrounding the historical value of this building took place. It was noted that the conservation officer has been involved in the design and access statements. The parish council was suspended and subsequently reinstated giving the applicant an opportunity to address the meeting.

2009/01000 Land Adjacent to Ferns, Lower Downgate - construction of 1 No Detached 3 bedroom house P Barriball chaired the meeting. It was proposed by D Parsons, seconded by M Joll with 7 councillors in favour of supporting this application for approval. 1 councillor was against supporting the application.
